You can complete this course at your own pace in a flexible way. You will have 8-10 weeks to complete all of the assessments.

Entry Requirements

Although there are no formal entry requirements for this course, due to the nature and course delivery of distance learning we require all applicants to hold a minimum of English Literacy Level 1 or equivalent.

If you are between 19 and 23 yrs of age you must also have already achieved a full level 2 qualification ie the equivalent of 5 GCSE Grades A-C.

Learners should be aged 19+.

Course Information

This qualification is designed for learners who want to increase their knowledge and understanding of supporting adults living with cancer. It could be used as a continuous professional development (CPD) qualification for learners already working within the health care and social care sectors or for individuals providing informal care.

There are four units which cover Cancer awareness, Introduction to the diagnosis and treatment of cancer, Introduction to cancer care and support as well as Introduction to end of life and bereavement care.

Assessment

Once enrolled you will be provided with access to our online platform. This will provide you with an online information booklet for you to read through. You then will need to submit answers to a range of assessment questions on the online platform.
