Although there are no formal entry requirements for this course, due to the nature and course delivery of distance learning we require all applicants to hold a minimum of English Literacy Level 1 or equivalent. It is also useful to have completed a level 2 course as preparation. This course is suitable for students aged 19 and over.

Course Information

This qualification enables learners to develop knowledge and understanding of caring for individuals with dementia. Successful completion of the units will allow learners to develop in-depth knowledge and understanding of dementia and its effects.

During this qualification learners will be taught the following:

- Types of dementia and the importance of early diagnosis
- Importance of person-centred approaches in dementia care
- The role of communication, interaction and inclusion in dementia care and support
- The use of medication to support individuals with dementia.

This course is free for adults aged over 24 years who do not already hold a Level 3 qualification.
